

### **OUR RESPONSE TO COVID-19**

Here is a summary of protocols OCA implemented March 23 - May 20, 2020 due to COVID-19:

### **Lower Elementary**

Stay at home enacted.

Instructional packets of school activities delivered by teachers or picked up from campus by appointment by parents.

# Elementary

Stay at home enacted.

Instructional packets of school assignments and activities delivered by teachers or picked up from campus by appointment by parents.

Weekly video chats set up individually with parents/students.

### Middle School

Stay at home enacted.

Student textbooks and assignments were delivered by teachers or picked up from campus by appointment by parents.

Video conferencing with the teacher was scheduled by grade level at least 1-2 hours per day 4-5 days per week.

# **High School**

Stav at home enacted.

Student textbooks and assignments were picked up from campus by appointment by parents. Online curriculum video streaming of classes was made available for all students.

## **Special Classes**

Art: Not available during fourth quarter/grades averaged from first three quarters.

Music: Semester grade based on pre-COVID-19 and fourth guarter home assignments.

Physical Education: Not available during fourth quarter/grades averaged from first three quarters.

## Standardized Testing

Stanford Achievement Tests were administered prior to school closure March 10-13, 2020.

#### **Progress Reports**

As regular coursework was consolidated to mastery of core learning objectives per subject per grade, "homework" was reduced or eliminated and grade evaluations were based on previous academic performance and completed assignments from the fourth quarter.

#### On-site Return

Classroom "Wrap-Up" was scheduled for May 19-20, 2020. Students were permitted back into their classrooms to clean out desks and collect all personal belongings and schoolwork.

Kindergarten/Senior Graduation and Preschool-Senior Awards commenced on May 22, 2020 following social distancing guidelines as given by the CDC and the state of Missouri.
